
1. Go for a run

Create a piece of artwork showing the stars you saw.




4. Take part in a yoga session.

Include a photograph of yourself feeding a farm animal.




7. Keep a food diary for a week.

Attach a copy of your food diary.


8. Visit a nature reserve.

Do your own landscape picture of the reserve.




9. Go on a butterfly hunt.

Create a flow chart showing the life cycle of a butterfly.




10. School Choice 1: Travel on a train.

24. Visit Birmingham.


Explain which hands you correctly hold a knife and fork in and what different utensils you may use to eat breakfast, lunch and dinner.

33. Create a piece of art using print methods.


Attach a copy of your artwork.

Draw your house and label it. Describe the location, materials and interior. Is there anything that makes your house unique?

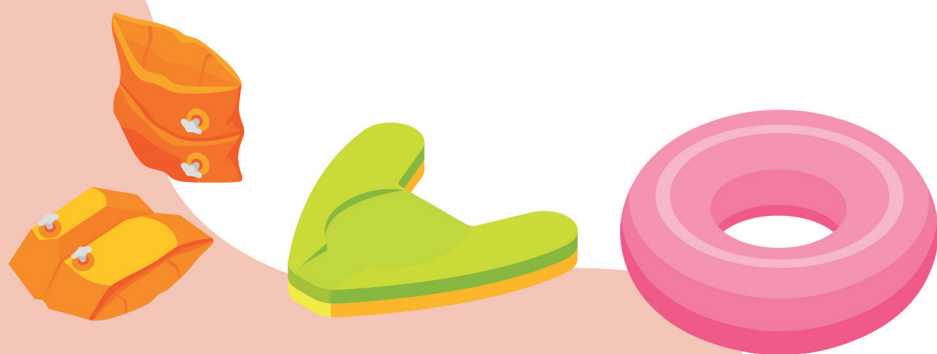


38. Write a blurb for a story book.
